SHO-TAI

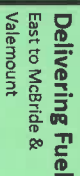

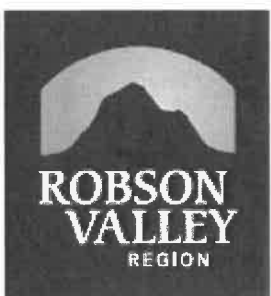
