In BC, the influenza vaccine is provided free to the following of people: \*People 65 years and older and their caregivers/household contacts. \*People of any age in residential care facilities. \*Children and adults with chronic health conditions and their household contacts. \*Children & adolescents (6 months to 18 years) with conditions treated for long periods of time with Acetylsalicylic Acid (ASA) and their household contacts. \*Children & Adults who are morbidly obese (adult BMI>40; child BMI assessed as >95th percentile adjusted for age and sex. \*Aboriginal people (on and off reserve). \*All healthy children 6-59 months of age. \*Household contacts and caregivers of infants and children 0-59 months of age. \*Pregnant women at any stage of pregnancy during the influenza season and their household contacts. \*Inmates or provincial correctional institutions. \*People who work with live poultry. \*Health care and other care providers in facilities and community settings who are capable of transmitting influenza disease to those at high risk of influenza complications. \*Visitors to health care facilities and other patient care locations. \*Individuals who provide care or service in potential outbreak settings housing high risk persons (e.g., crew on ships). \*People who provide essential community services (first responders, corrections officers).
