Dorothy Elizabeth Hewitt

December 15, 1919-January 2, 2018. It is with great sadness that Dorothy (Grandma Dot) passed away peacefully on January 2, 2018 with granddaughter Kathy Molendyk by her side. On December 15th, 1919 Wesley and Gladys Basso gave birth at home in Sundridge, Ontario to their 1st born, Dorothy Elizabeth Basso who weighed in at less than 2 lbs. She was so tiny that the local doctor didn't think that she would survive the night. Her dad ensured this wouldn't happen by laying her on bricks in the wood heated oven to keep her warm. Dorothy was the oldest of 14 children so she spent much of her time helping her mom with the siblings and many, many chores. On December 27, 1939 she married Alfred Frank Hewitt and moved to Winnipeg where he worked for the Army. In 1941 he enlisted with the navy and in early 1942 they moved to Victoria where he was stationed. On July 31, 1942, Dorothy gave birth to Marilyn, their only child. They moved to a small community called Saanichton on the outskirts of Victoria where they had a small hobby farm. In 1961 Marilyn married and later that year Dorothy and Alf had their 1st granddaughter followed by another in 1963. After a tragic accident to Marilyn's husband she remarried and had 2 grandsons in 1974 and 1976. In 1968 Alf and Dorothy bought property by Snowshoe Creek in Looos, BC and moved there in 1970 to retire and do some farming. This was the happiest time of her life. She loved the people, clean air and beautiful mountains and "the best water you've ever tasted". In 1980, they moved to McBride as the farm was getting too much for them. In 2001 Alfred passed away and Dorothy continued to live in their little home and became involved in the Evangelical Church, Senior's Carpet Bowling, played crib or scrabble against anyone that would challenge her, enjoyed travelling with Granddaughter Kathy and spending as much time as she could with her other grandchildren, great grandchildren and great great grandchildren. She is survived by her Granddaughters Kathy Molendyk & Velvet (Nigel) Jesticoo, Grandsons Ian Smith, Paul Smith (Iris Tappert-Siriam), Great Grandsons Jamie (Tina Pepper) and Shawn (Karina) Molendyk, Novah Anderson and Memphis Smith, Great Great Grandson's Tanner, Keegan Kole and Great Great Granddaughters Paige and Paylyn Molendyk. Grandma was the oldest of 14 and is survived by Brothers, Dave, Al (Andrea), Dale (Anna), Howard (Sandra) and Bob (Sharon) and Sister Emily (Joe) and sister-in-law Linda. Many, many nieces and nephews and one favorite nephew who also took time to visit almost every year Allan Basso. She is predeceased by husband Alfred, daughter Marilyn, brothers Murray, Wes, Roy and Don, sisters Joan, Jean and Donald. In the summer, there will be a burial in Looos where her husband (grandad) Alfred Hewitt and their daughter Marilyn are. At that time grandma's brothers and sister, other family members and friends are hoping to attend. Grandma, thank you for sharing your life with us. You are truly a gift to us, an inspiration to take this life and live it. You are loved by all that you have crossed paths with. We will love you forever and always. Grandma thought that "Josh's Place" was a great addition to the community and was very happy to hear that so many children from the valley enjoy all the activities organized by Evangelical Church.
