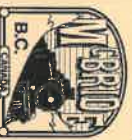

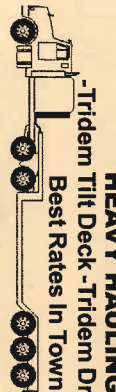

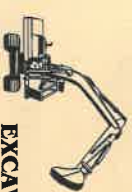

### McBride Mountain Trails Updates

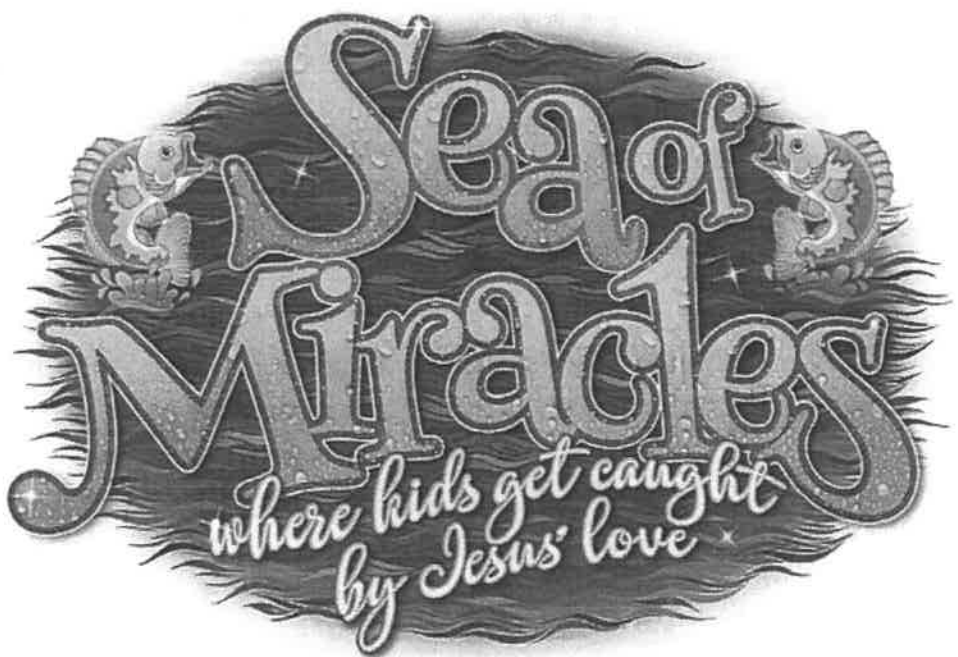
