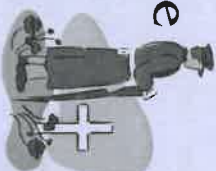

1994-2018.



Bryan William Beer, son of Stan and Deanna Beer, was born on February 28, 1994 in Prince George BC. He grew up in McBride BC with his two sisters Nicole and Ashley. Bryan attended McBride Elementary and graduated from McBride Secondary in 2012.

After graduation Bryan worked for JNR Auto for almost 3 years before attending the "Think Big" program for Fitting in Fairview AB where he earned his Heavy Duty Mechanic Technician title. Bryan then moved to Sakatoon SK where daily he got to live out his passion for mechanics while working for Fitting Canada. Bryan's favorite hobbies included hunting, fishing, remote control planes, model cars but mostly working on his 1981 Trans Am. On October 19, 2018 Bryan was tragically killed in a workplace incident by no fault of his own. He was only 24 years old. Bryan is survived by his parents Stan and Deanna Beer, 2 sisters Nicole (Jarey) and Ashley (Preston), Nephews: Kingston, Karter, Ryker and Colten, Nieces: Kaylee and Harper and many extended family members and friends. 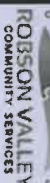

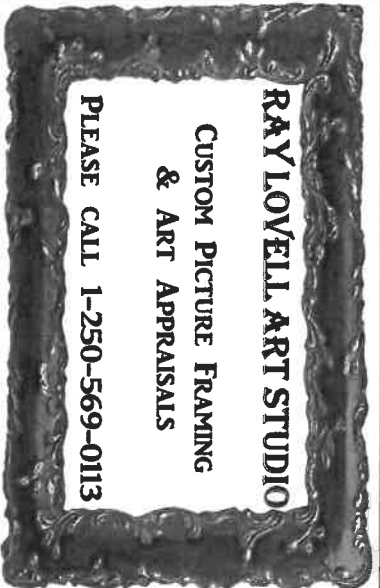
