## COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS

**COMMUNITY GAMING GRANT APPLICATIONS CONTINUE TO BE A SUCCESS!** The McBride Elks and Royal Purple are happy to announce the successful Community Gaming Grant applicants for the 2019 year. This year, there were 7 clubs or organizations that applied for a total of \$31,500.00. Between both the Elks and Royal Purple we received in Community Gaming Funds \$22,000 to help support the following groups: Valley Pilecramers Quilters, McBride Secondary PAC, McBride Centennial PAC, Robson Valley Youth Softball, McBride Figure Skating, Seventh Day Adventist Food Bank and the Dunster Station Museum. We will be applying for a new Community Gaming Fund Grant for 2020. If you think that your club or organization will need help with funding, please provide the following information: complete description and delivery of program including community benefit, accessibility, sustainability and community support; what level of grant funding you are requesting; describe in detail how the grant funds will be used; how many people will participate in, or benefit from the program. A part of our grant application requires, that we document volunteer hours that your members put in. This volunteer time can include meetings, programs, coaches, drivers, and projects, etc. For every dollar that we receive in gaming funds, we need to show a minimum of 25% volunteer time (converted to money), so for example for every \$1000, we need to show \$250 in volunteer time (which results in 12.5 hours volunteer time). The more volunteer hours that you spend delivering your program, the higher our chances of obtaining more funding as it shows a greater "buy-in" from the community. Applications are due in by no later than June 30, 2019 to McBride Royal Purple Box 336, McBride, BC V0J 2E0 or McBride Elks, Box 65, McBride, BC V0J 2E0.
