



COUNCIL WILL APPOINT THREE DIRECTORS AT MCBRIDE COMMUNITY FOREST AGM IN OCTOBER. Applications will be received beginning August 26, 2019. The Village of McBride, on behalf of the McBride Community Forest Corporation, will be hosting the 2019 Annual General Meeting on Wednesday, October 16, 2019 where three directors to the Corporation's Board will be appointed by the Community Forest's Shareholder.
