Applications will be received beginning August 26, 2019. 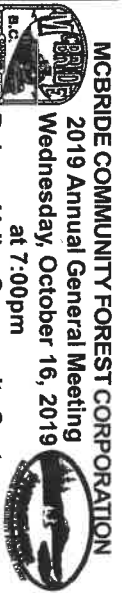
