

## VILLAGE OF MCBRIDE

The Village of McBride would like to thank everyone who participated in the Focus Groups and the Housing Town Hall Meetings on October 9th and 10th. Rhonda Eager from David Naima and Associates, met with 45 individuals from the 3 Focus Groups and the McBride and District Housing Society over the course of the two days. A separate meeting prior to the Town Hall Meeting was held with the Village's Mayor, Council and Administration and there were approximately 20 people who attended the Town Hall meeting. Although a housing assessment for McBride had been completed in previous years, the Province now requires Municipalities and Regional Districts in B.C. to complete housing needs and demand reports by April 2022 and every five years thereafter. Housing needs reports are a way for communities to better understand their current and future housing needs. These reports can help identify existing and projected gaps in housing supply by collecting and analyzing quantitative and qualitative information about local demographics, economics, housing stock, and other factors. A housing needs report is critical to developing a housing strategy or action plan in order to apply for any funding programs through BC Housing in the future. A Housing Survey will be available to McBride, Dome Creek, Crescent Spur and Dunster residents within the next 10 days to gather further information on housing needs and demands in the Robson Valley.
