The Library's Board of Directors have put the proceeds from the sale into a reserve account. Our goal is to pay down as much of the debt as possible for the Robson Valley Exploration and Learning Centre (521 Main Street). Due to the borrowing terms of the Municipal Finance Authority, however, no monies can be applied until the ten year mark. This will come in 2028. As we settle into our new space, staff and board members have developed a new strategic plan. Our goals and strategies are based on community input over the last few years.
