Dale Edward Steiner

Born February 6, 1950 - Passed Away October 16, 2019.
Dale Edward Steiner, of Salmon Arm, British Columbia, died peacefully at home, surrounded by family and friends, on October 16, 2019, at the age 69 years, 8 months, and 10 days. He was born on February 6, 1950 to Carl & Dorothy (Eberly) Steiner in Orrville, Ohio. At 13 years old, Dale moved with his parents to Barwick, Ontario to start the church there. At age 15, Dale committed his life to God and was baptized upon the confession of his faith and became a member of the Pineview Mennonite Church. As a youth, he did welding, farming, logging, and mechanic work. At age 19, Dale attended Messiah Bible School in Ohio, and met Miriam Baer. On October 28, 1970, Dale and Miriam were joined in Holy Matrimony at McBride, B.C. They started married life near Zurich, On, and attended Lakeview Mennonite Church. Dale drove truck for Martin Transport and worked for Alvin Baker in logging. In 1972, Dale and Miriam, with their first-born son Edwin, moved to McBride, B.C. Dale drove logging truck for many years, eventually buying his own truck. In 1987, Dale bought his own logging equipment and logged for Zeidler Forest Industries. In 2002 he had an auction and sold all his logging equipment. He enjoyed taking trips with his family. He took them to Dominican Republic and Philippines, across Canada and to many states. He enjoyed meeting new people and seeing new places. In 2004, Dale and Miriam moved to Salmon Arm, B.C. to help start the church there. He started raising beef cattle and farmed until he passed away. Dale was a member of the Salmon Arm Mennonite Church at the time of his death. Beginning in June 2017, Dale's health began to decline. After not being able to find help locally, he went to Tijuana, Mexico and was diagnosed with Multiple Myeloma. After four months in Mexico, he had six more months of treatments at home. In August 2018, he and his family praised God for a "cancer free" diagnosis. The cancer returned in January 2019, and his health deteriorated until his death. Dale is loved and missed by Miriam, his wife of almost 49 years, and 8 children: Edwin (Keren) of Rosebush, MI; Charles (Eather Mae) of Port Clements, B.C.; Jessica (Joey) Alspaugh of Chewah, W.A.; Roxanne (Rod) Wagler of Poltonia, MB; Teresa of Salmon Arm, B.C.; Delphine (Wes) Reimer of Salmon Arm, B.C.; Scot (Melinda) of Monte Creek, B.C.; and Veronica of Salmon Arm, B.C.. 35 living grandchildren and 3 great-grandchildren. Dale was dad and grandpa to many foster children over the years as well. Dale was preceded in death by his parents, grandson Jeffrey, and sister Nancy.
