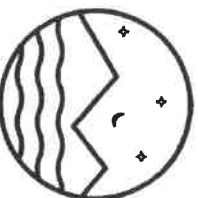

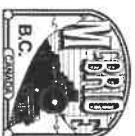

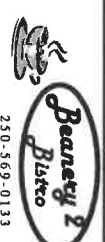

April 20, 2020

Cold spring weather over the past month has transitioned to climbing temperatures over the past several days increasing snowmelt rates.

Temperatures are expected to continue to rise, resulting in continued snowmelt and run-off. This situation is already starting to create fluctuating Turbidity levels at the Village's water intake system due to the seasonal freshet (snow melt).
