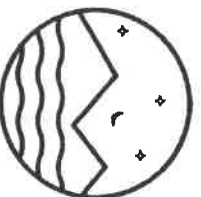

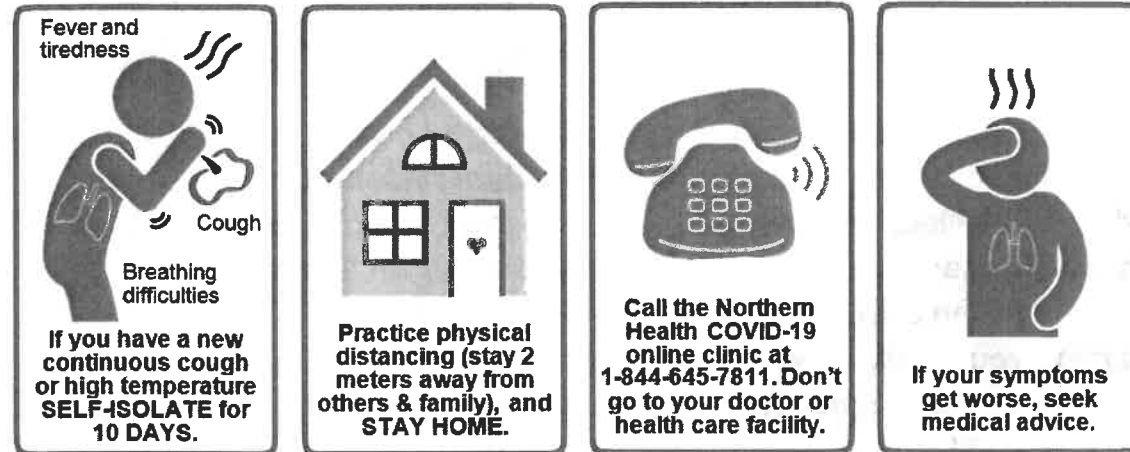

WHAT ARE THE SYMPTOMS AND WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I FEEL UNWELL?

- **Cough.** A new, continuous, dry cough. This means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours.
- **Fever**
- **Breathing Difficulties**
- **Generalized Muscle Pain**
- **Headache**
- **Sore Throat**

Some people with the infection will have mild symptoms, or none at all, but they can still spread the virus to others – who might develop more severe symptoms.



If you are experiencing symptoms you should:

1. Call the NH COVID-19 Online Clinic at **1-844-645-7811**.
2. Don't go to your doctor's office without **phoning ahead**. If you have questions, call your family doctor or nurse practitioner.
3. **SELF-ISOLATE** for 10 days in your home, along with your family members.

HOW LONG SHOULD I SELF-ISOLATE FOR?

1. If you are returning from travel, you need to self-isolate for **14 days** (even if you don't have symptoms).
2. If you have symptoms of COVID-19, you need to stay home for **10 days**.
3. If you live with someone who has developed symptoms, you need to stay home for **10 days** from the day the first person in the home started having symptoms.
4. After 10 days (14 days after coming back from travel), if your temperature is normal and you feel better you can go back to practicing Physical Distancing.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN SELF-ISOLATION AND PHYSICAL-DISTANCING?

- **Self-Isolation:** staying at home and avoiding situations where you could infect other people. People at high-risk of having been exposed to the virus are asked to self-isolate.
- **Physical Distancing:** staying 2 meters (6 feet) apart from others when outside the home.

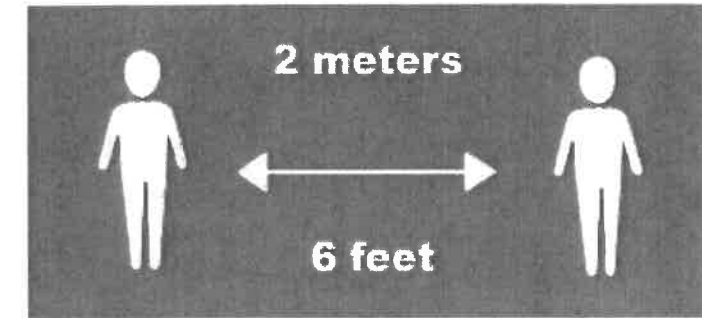

HOW CAN I AVOID GETTING AND SPREADING THE VIRUS?

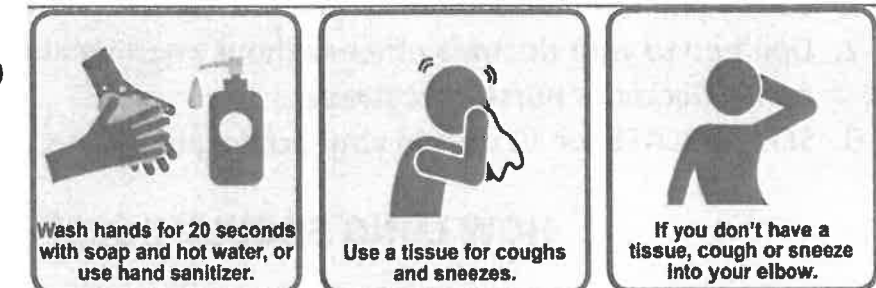
1. PRACTICE PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- Avoid close contact with other people. Keep at least **2 meters (6 feet)** away from them.
- Limit trips out of your home for essential items such as groceries to **once a week**.
- **Work from home** – speak to your employer about this.
- **Avoid social activities** such as going to restaurants or other busy areas.
- **DO NOT attend events with groups of more than 50 people**
- **Avoid going on children's playdates**, such as going to a playground or park.
- **Don't have visitors to your home. This includes friends and family**
 - (other than the family members you live with).
- Don't go to your doctor's office without **phoning ahead**. If you have questions, call your family doctor or nurse practitioner. You can also call the NH COVID-19 Online Clinic at **1-844-645-7811**.



2. WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN

- Wash your hands often with soap and water– for at least **20 seconds**.
- Always wash your hands when you get home or arrive at work.



3. USE HAND SANTIZER If soap and water are unavailable

4. USE COUGHING ETIQUETTE

- Cough or sneeze into your elbow, or into a tissue.
- Put used tissues in the garbage immediately, and then wash your hands.



5. AVOID TOUCHING YOUR FACE

- Avoid touching your face, eyes, nose, or mouth.

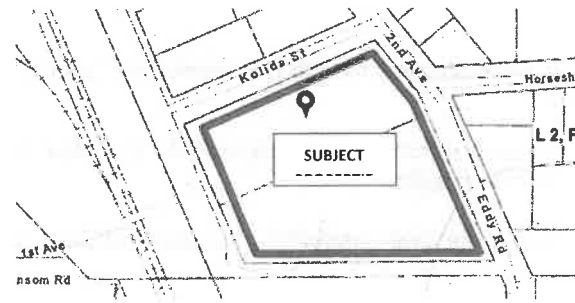

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Village of McBride as part of a Regular Council meeting on **Tuesday, the 14th day of April, 2020 at the hour of 7:00 p.m.** will hold a virtual Public Hearing by means of an electronic meeting, due to the COVID-19 situation, to hear all persons interested in supporting or objecting to **Village of McBride Zoning Bylaw Amendment Bylaw No. 788, 2019** being a Bylaw to amend the "Village of McBride Zoning Bylaw No. 703, 2010".

- Applicant:** Doug Monroe and Profor Management Inc.
- Location:** 1479 2nd Ave and 1413 2nd Ave
- Legal Description:** Lot A, Plan BCP6712, District Lot 5316, Cariboo Land District and Lot 1, Except Part Plan BCP 6712, D/L 5316, Cariboo Land District, PGP 35669



Purpose: To accommodate a private senior focused phased development of mixed residential units and shared common facilities

Bylaw Being Considered **Zoning Bylaw Amendment Bylaw No. 788,2019**
To amend the zoning designation on the subject property from Residential Zone (R2) and Rural Industrial (M 1) to Residential 4 Multi-family (R4) Zone and allow for regulations to accommodate a mix of residential units and shared common facilities for senior. This zoning amendment will be specific to this legal description and address.

On March 25, 2020 the Minister of Public Safety and Solicitor General made the Bylaw Enforcement Officer (COVID-19) Order, and on March 31, 2020 made the Provincial Compliance Officer (COVID-19) Order), both pursuant to the *Emergency Program Act*.

These Orders enable Compliance and Enforcement Officers (Bylaw Officers and other Provincial Compliance Officers) to provide assistance for the compliance and enforcement of public health through monitoring and providing warnings, information and advice.

The Province has adopted and implemented a graduated compliance and enforcement approach that generally starts with providing information, education and advice as the first step, with escalating measured enforcement only as required.

The Village of McBride in response and compliance to the Minister's Orders, is pleased to announce that Pete Berndsen, as of April 2, 2020 has joined the Village of McBride's Emergency Operation Centre (EOC) as a Bylaw Officer.

Pete Berndsen will be working with the Village's Emergency Management team to support both Minister Farnworth, Public Safety and Solicitor General's ministerial orders and Dr. Bonnie Henry, Provincial Health Officer's recommendations and orders during this period of COVID-19 pandemic.

Bylaw Officer, Pete Berndsen, will be available 9 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday to assist and support the Village of McBride's EOC, businesses and community members.
