DO NOT CONSUME NOTICE – UPDATE as of July 13, 2020

In consultation with Northern Health and the Drinking Water Officer, the Village of McBride on June 24, 2020 issued a “DO NOT CONSUME NOTICE” pursuant to Section 14 of the *Drinking Protection Act*.

Northern Health and the Village of McBride are actively monitoring the water quality situation at the Dominion Creek (water source) on a day to day basis.

As of today, the Village Community Water System has the first sign of evidence that a trend of low turbidity is being established. Once this low turbidity trend is established on a consistent basis over a period of days, Northern Health will downgrade the Do Not Consume Notice to a Boil Water Notice.

Northern Health, working with the Village will re-evaluate the overall situation later this week as the weather forecast is once again calling for the same unsettled and rainy weather pattern for Wednesday through to Saturday. This unsettled weather pattern may have an adverse effect on Dominion Creek as it is vulnerable at this time to further freshet activity.

Since June 24, 2020 there has been no evidence of chemical contamination however a chemical analysis of the water will be arranged and performed this week. Northern Health under normal operating conditions requires the Village to perform a chemical analysis of the water every three years and Northern Health provides the requisitions for this sampling.

Thank you again for your continued patience during this unprecedented Spring freshet.

A further update will be provided on Thursday, July 16, 2020.

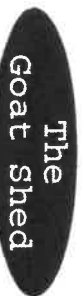
