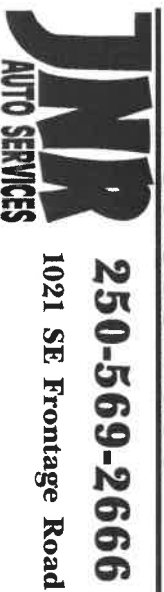

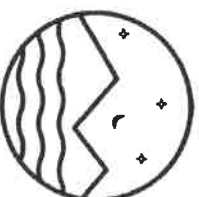

2020 Property Tax Notice Payment Reminder**

**The Penalty Deadline for Unpaid 2020 Property Taxes has been Extended to October 1, 2020 for All Property Tax Classes.** Payments must be received in the Village office by October 1, 2020 or a 10% penalty will be applied to all unpaid 2020 taxes and this includes homeowner grants. The Property Tax due date still remained as July 2, 2020.

**Eligible Taxpayers are Urged to Apply for their Homeowner Grant as soon possible.** It is not necessary to make a payment in order to claim the grant.

**The signed Homeowner Grant must be returned even if you are paying the balance of your taxes later or with your mortgage.**

**How to Pay your 2020 Property Taxes:**

1. Cheque or Money Order: Mail to the Village of McBride
2. Online at: Scotiabank, TD Bank, Bank of Montreal, Central 1 Credit Unions
3. Scotiabank McBride will take payment in person at the McBride Branch.
4. At the Village Office: Village Office hours are 9:00 am to 4:00 pm Monday to Wednesday until further notice.
