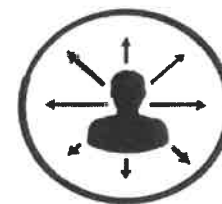

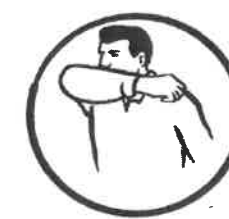

Corporation of the Village of McBride 2020 Property Tax Notice Payment Reminder

The Penalty Deadline for Unpaid 2020 Property Taxes has been Extended to **October 1, 2020 for All Property Tax Classes**. Payments must be received in the Village office by October 1, 2020 or a 10% penalty will be applied to all unpaid 2020 taxes and this includes homeowner grants. The Property Tax due date still remained as July 2, 2020.

Eligible Taxpayers are Urged to Apply for their Homeowner Grant as soon possible. It is not necessary to make a payment in order to claim the grant.

The signed Homeowner Grant must be returned even if you are paying the balance of your taxes later or with your mortgage.

How to Pay your 2020 Property Taxes:

1. Cheque or Money Order: Mail to the Village of McBride
2. Online at: Scotiabank, TD Bank, Bank of Montreal, Central 1 Credit Unions
3. Scotiabank McBride will take payment in person at the McBride Branch.
4. At the Village Office: Village Office hours are 9:00 am to 4:00 pm Monday to Wednesday until further notice.
