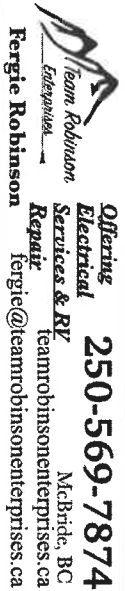

Mom and Dad had a small hobby farm, they both loved horses and were very active in fall fair and gymkhana's a meal for the neighbours if they popped by, coffee pot was always on. Mom lost the love of her life at a young age, she raised 3 girls worked hard to do so long hours, never begrudging it for a moment. In later years she loved to travel with friends and family, carpet bowl, have people come to visit and she was known for her famous pies at farmers market. Her favorite outings were the Sandman, for liver and onions if Wes was cooking, Kilin, the Beanery, never missing 9am opening a place she worked as a young lady, Mom always knew where the best places to berry pick were and loved to garden. She loved to ride a horse, and did when she could up to age 85. Mom was predeceased by many siblings, her parents, and her loving husband John, she will be dearly missed by her 3 daughters Irene, Heather, and Jacqueline, and her sister Jacqueline, numerous nieces and nephews and cousins, 8 grandchildren, Jon/ Nikki, Jessie/Trina, Robert and Brice/Rodi Littlechild, Christopher and Michelle Rejman, Rachel and Brihana Kent, 6 Great grandchildren, Billie and Kyra, Angela, Levi, Blaze, and Stella Littlechild, soon she would have been a great great grandmother to a new little angel arriving in the spring.
