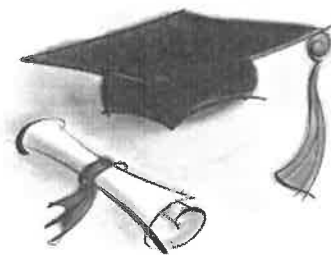
Students are to write a 1000-word essay that best describes why they are choosing their field of study or career training, preference to those pursuing Natural Resources.
