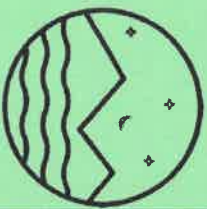

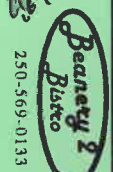

#### Campfire and Open Burning BAN – Wednesday, June 30, 2021 12:00pm



Effective, Wednesday, June 30, 2021 at 12:00pm, the Province is banning all open burning (including campfires) across the Province. #### Internet Speed Testing

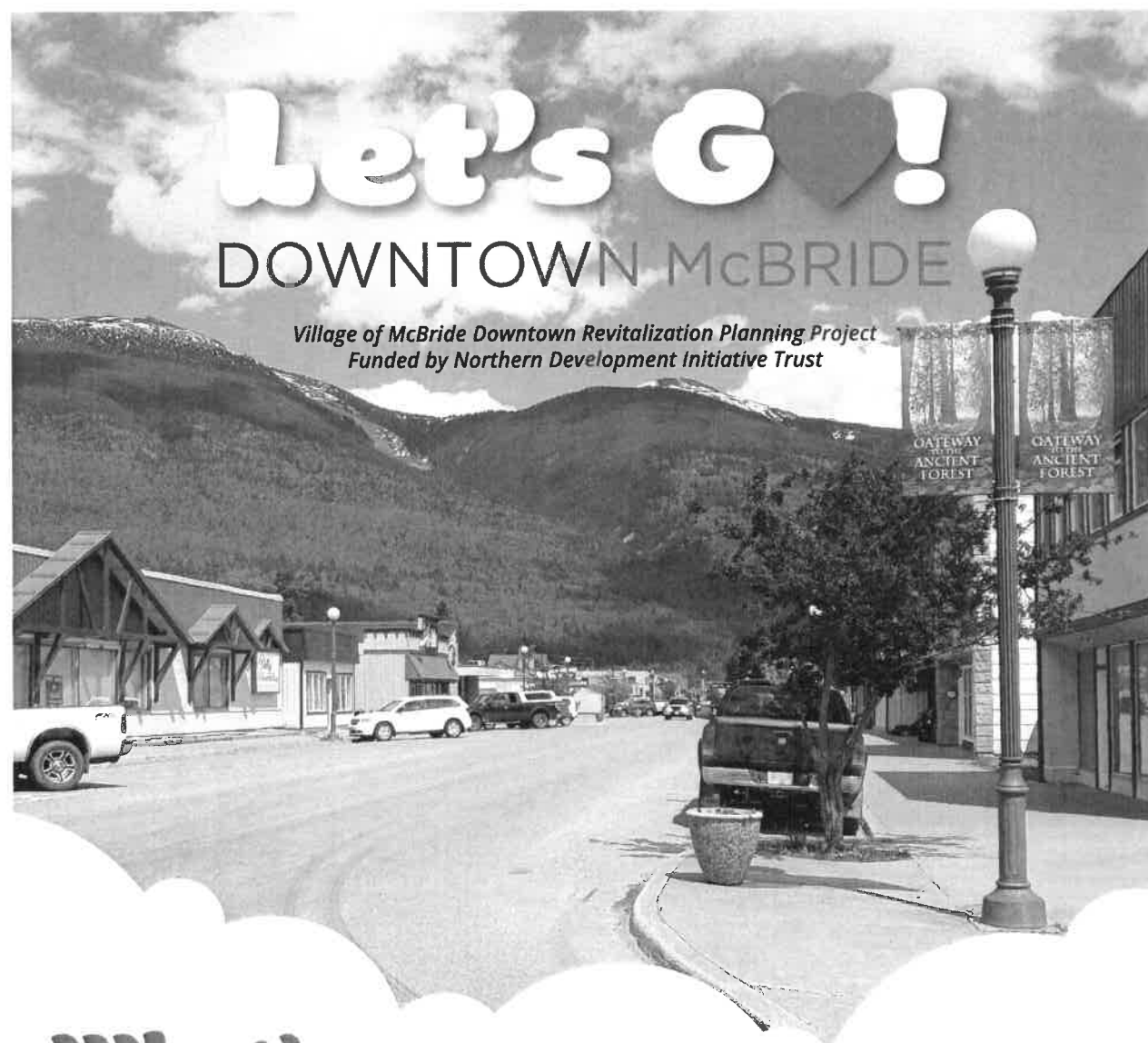
