Dave Lamey - August 27, 1952 - October 14, 2021. It is with great sadness that we announce the death of Dave Lamey on Thursday, October 14, 2021. Dave is survived by his wife Coral & his brothers Don and Peter. As requested by Dave, there will be no service.

Clarence N. Miller, born October 10, 1941 near Independence, Iowa, passed away peacefully surrounded by family at his home in McBride on October 15, 2021. The Lord blessed him with 80 years and 5 days. He was the oldest son of Noah and Lydia (Gingerich) Miller. He is survived by his beloved wife, Elizabeth Mae (Baer) Miller; 3 sons and 2 daughters: Joseph (Brenda) Miller of Watoma, Wisconsin; Evan (Regina) Miller of Thorp, Wisconsin; Ruth (Kevin) Horst of Fortuna, California; Ray (Dorothy) Miller of McBride, B.C.; Faye (Steven) of Denmark, Wisconsin; 41 grandchildren, and 9 great-grandchildren; 5 brothers and 6 sisters. He was preceded in death by a son, Wilmer, a grandson, Devon Miller, and a brother Ivan. Clarence lived with his parents in Buchanan County, Iowa till the age of 7 years when he moved with his family to Kalona, Iowa. He received Christ as his personal Saviour in his youth and was baptized at the Fairview Conservative Mennonite Church near Kalona. At the age of 22, he went to Red Lake, Ontario for 2 years of 1-w service. In 1964, Clarence met Elizabeth at Messiah Bible School in Ohio, and a special friendship developed. They were married March 11, 1967 at McBride, and enjoyed 54 years together. Clarence was ordained minister for the McBride congregation in 1979. He, with his family, served in mission work in the Philippines from 1983 to 1987. Upon his return to Canada, he was ordained bishop at McBride in 1988, and was involved in bishop responsibilities in the Philippines and in various Canadian churches over the years. General carpentry and construction occupied his time when he was not busy with church work. He faithfully labored for the Lord in these duties till he was diagnosed with cancer in April of 2021. His health continued to deteriorate steadily till the time of his death. He will be greatly missed by his family and remembered for his deep burden for strong Christian homes and stable churches.

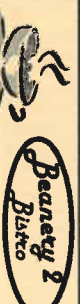

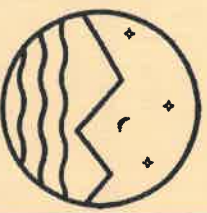
