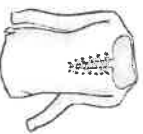

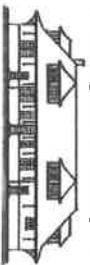

Grades 5/6/7 Land Acknowledgement and Stewardship Art Project. Project Rationale: Canada is a nation of diversity - socially, culturally and ecologically. Ecologically, Canada is blessed with unique and distinct landscape regions. Each has its own unique natural features and climate; and each supports its own distinct species of animals and plants. As the journey towards reconciliation continues, and we strive to fulfil the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's (TRC) calls to action, it is important that we continue to build relationships and engage in ongoing education. Reconciliation and allyship is a continuous process and one that we all need to engage in fully. With this in mind, we must take every appropriate opportunity to acknowledge the traditional territory on which we reside. 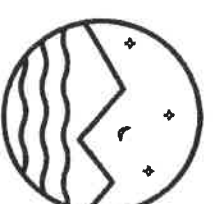
