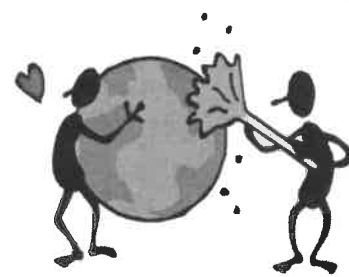

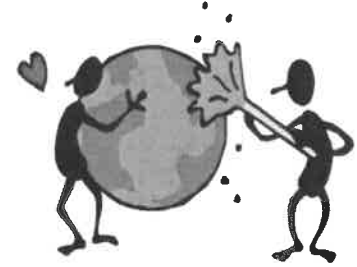

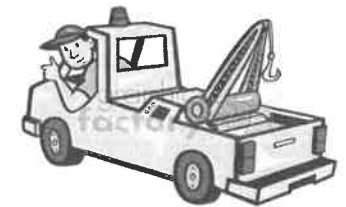

2022 - 2026 Five-year Financial Plan, and 2022 Tax Rate Bylaw

The Village of McBride 2022-2026 Five-Year Financial Plan and 2022 Tax Rate Bylaws must be adopted prior to May 12, 2022.

A public consultation opportunity will be provided prior to adoption of the bylaws at the April 28, 2022 Special Council Meeting.

The Public Consultation Meeting will be held at **7:00 p.m. on April 21, 2022 in person at 100 Robson Centre**. Anyone wishing to participate electronically can request a Zoom link by emailing admin-assist@McBride.ca or calling (250) 569-2229 by 12:00 p.m. on April 21, 2022.

In addition, the public can also e-mail their feedback to McBride@McBride.ca by 8:00 a.m. on April 25, 2022, which will be provided to Council for the Regular Council Meeting on April 26, 2022.

The first reading for Five-Year Financial Plan and 2022 Tax Rate Bylaw will be presented at the Special Council Meeting on April 19, 2022. The Agenda will be posted to the Village's website by 4:00 p.m. on April 14, 2022 for all interested members of the public.

The Village welcomes all public feedback for the 2022-2026 Financial Plan and 2022 Tax Rate Bylaw.

Career Opportunities with the Village of McBride

Two new full-time permanent senior management positions have been created at the Village of McBride resulting from a full organizational review undertaken in 2021:

- 1. Deputy Corporate Officer** - This position provides support to the CAO, Mayor and Council and senior management by performing a variety of complex and confidential administrative duties associated with relevant municipal legislation, corporate records management, and Council/Committee processes and protocols. This position is also responsible for Human Resources, Information Services and Economic Development and Tourism functions.
- 2. Director of Operations and Capital Projects** – This position provides oversight and leadership for the Operations Department including water and wastewater utilities, engineering, capital projects, project and airport management, and bylaw enforcement. This position continuously reviews, recommends, and implements enhancements to efficiency and effectiveness as it relates to service delivery. Additionally, the position will provide expert advice at public and technical meetings, and present reports at both Council and regional meetings as required (some evenings).
