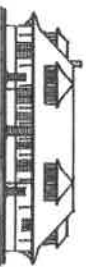

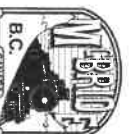

McBride's past and present community members; the long-standing Elks and Royal Purple Club is in dire straits and are seeking to generate financial support for the club. But now the Elks and Royal Purple needs the community's support. Due to the age of our building, there has been some much-needed renovations; such as a new heating system and wheelchair accessible doors installed to bring some things to code. We applied and received grants for some of this, however the overall cost was higher than what we received. Along with monthly/annually expenses of running the building and with very little revenue coming into the building due to COVID we are stretched to our limits. Our main fundraiser for the operation of the building has always been Pioneer Days. Since COVID restrictions has not allowed us to run the event for the past two years, our coffers are at an all time low and we need an influx of cash, hoping that this June's Pioneer Days will allow us to stay afloat!
