A Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, July 12, 2022 beginning at 7:00 pm in Council Chambers located at 100 Robson Centre.
Zoning Amendment Bylaw 810, 2022 will be considered at this Public Hearing. Amendments to Zoning Bylaw 703, 2010 include the following:

- Addition of "Hotel" in the "Highway Commercial (C2)" Zone
- Rezoning 797 Bridge Rd. from R2 to C2 to permit a hotel
- Site specific text amendment: 275 McBride South Rd.
- Amended Definition of "Retail" to permit bulk sales
- Section 11.10 - Reduction of maximum building height of Residential Multi-Family Building from 12m to 10.4m

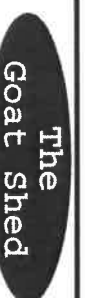
Anyone who believes they will be affected by the proposed Bylaw amendments is invited to attend the public hearing to present verbal or written submissions to Council for consideration.
