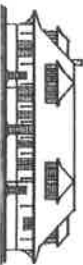

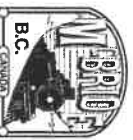

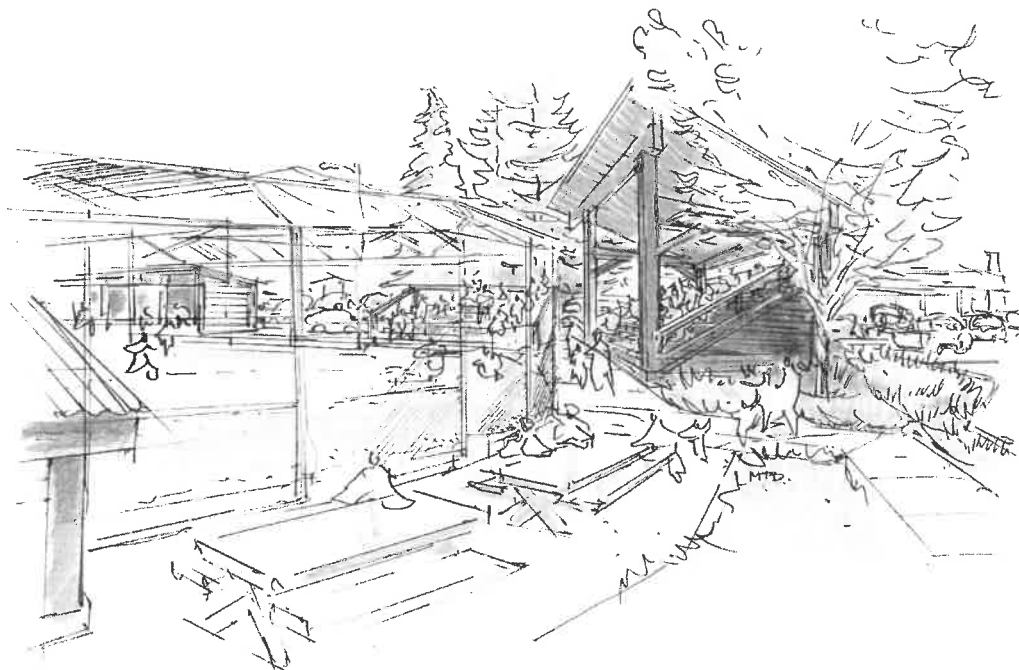
Funding for this project was made available from Pacific Economic Development Canada through the Canada Community Revitalization Fund.
