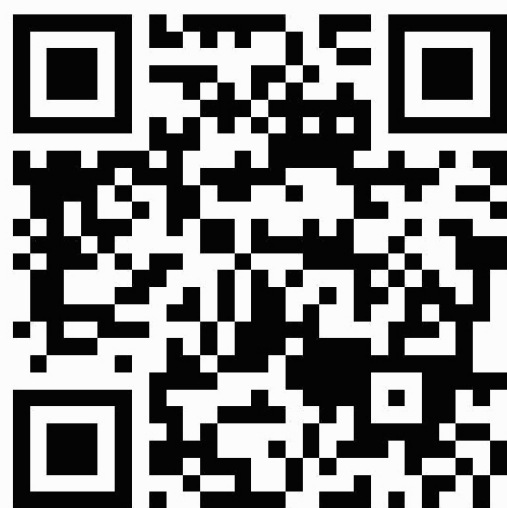

Sewer cleaning and inspections will be completed in McBride by Northern Lights, from Saturday, September 24, 2022 through Tuesday, October 4, 2022. Cleaning and inspections keep the sewer system operating efficiently by:

- Helping to prevent blockages and backups;
- Removing built-up debris such as roots, grease, grit, and sand;
- Determining the condition of the sewer for repair and replace as necessary.
