



Declaration of State of Local Emergency ORDER

September 19, 2023

WHEREAS severe drought (Drought Level 5) in and around the Village of McBride is impacting the municipality's Community Drinking Water System;

AND WHEREAS the impacts of drought on the McBride Community Drinking Water System poses an existing or imminent threat to the ability of the Village of McBride to provide adequate water to the people and property within the area known as *the* Village of McBride for drinking, sanitary service and fire protection;

AND WHEREAS this water emergency requires prompt coordination of action or special regulation of persons or property to protect the health, safety or welfare of people or to limit damage to property;

NOW THEREFORE:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the Emergency Program Act (RS, 1996, Chap 111) that a state of local emergency exists in the Village of McBride due to unprecedented low flows in Dominion Creek and McBride's Community Drinking Water System, threatening the municipality's ability to provide adequate water for drinking, fire suppression and sanitation service;


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the Village of McBride, its employees, servants and agents are empowered pursuant to *Section 13 (1) of the Emergency Program Act* to do all acts and implement all procedures that are considered necessary to prevent or to alleviate the effects of the emergency.

ORDERED by Resolution of Council at a Special Meeting held in Vancouver, BC on Tuesday, September 19, 2023, to remain in force for seven days until September 25, 2023, at midnight unless cancelled by the Village of McBride or the Minster responsible.

WATER USAGE RESTRICTION ORDER

EFFECTIVE 12:00AM, WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 20, 2023

Pursuant to the Authority of Section 13(1) of the Emergency Program Act, the Village of McBride is ordering Water Usage Restrictions, effective 12:00 am on Wednesday, September 20, 2023, until further notice, to ensure adequate water supply for drinking, fire protection and sanitary service.

WATER USEAGE RESTRICTIONS:

Lawn Sprinkling	- NOT PERMITTED	Garden Sprinkling	- NOT PERMITTED
Outdoor Hand Watering	- NOT PERMITTED	Drip Irrigation	- NOT PERMITTED
Washing of vehicles, building exteriors, driveways, sidewalks	 NOT PERMITTED (Unless ordered by a regulatory authority) 	Bulk Water Use: filling swimming pools, hot tubs, garden ponds, fountains	– NOT PERMITTED

On Thursday, September 14, 2023, the Province raised the Drought Level in the Robson Valley to Level 5, the highest on the scale. Dominion Creek, which supplies the McBride Community Drinking Water System, is experiencing extremely low flows due to the ongoing, severe drought conditions. A <u>Water Conservation Notice</u>, issued by the Village on May 17, 2023, reminding residents of year-round sprinkling restrictions, and a <u>News Release</u> issued on July 11, 2023, urging additional, voluntary water conservation, have not resulted in reduced water use. Water Usage Restrictions are necessary to ensure essential community services like drinking water, sanitary service and fire protection can be provided during this period of drought.

The Village of McBride recognizes the community and social value of Robson Valley Community and Recreation Centre facilities and has confirmed with the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George that water use for operations at these facilities is permitted, including ice making. The Village of McBride and Regional District are working closely on measures to reduce water usage at these facilities.




