If you do not have access to the BC Wildfire Service App for any reason, you can also access up-to-date fire information, for topics such as fire danger ratings and wildfire activity by calling **1-888-336-7378**.

To report a wildfire or irresponsible behaviour that could start a wildfire, please call **1-800-663-5555** or *5555 from a cell phone as soon as possible.

State of Local Emergency Rescinded

As of May 17, 2024 the state of local emergency was cancelled as the level 5 drought emergency has been reduced to a level 3 drought classification.

Water Bylaw No.737, 2013 states that regardless of SOLE, there are still a few water use restrictions in place.

SCHEDULE "C" WATER USE RESTRICTIONS

In all areas served under this Bylaw:

a. No Sprinkling is allowed between 12:00 noon and 5:00 pm daily.

Watering Regulations:

- a. Only those properties with a civic address ending in an even number may sprinkle lawn on that property on even numbered days.
- Only those properties with a civic address ending in an odd number, may sprinkle lawn on that property on odd numbered days.

Business Licences / Mobile Vendors / Farmers Markets

As we head into the summer months and activity increases for various Community events, the Village is being asked questions about Business Licences, Mobile Vendors and Farmers Markets, and wants to ensure that accurate information is being provided to the Village's residents and various business owners to help ensure a smooth and successful season ahead.

- ➤ Village Business Licence Bylaw: an application and fee payment are required, and if a business plans to sell food, then an approval or a Health Permit may be required from Northern Health. If needed, the applicant is to provide this to the Village to ensure the business licence is valid, and more information can be obtained from the Northern Health at www.northernhealth.ca.
- > Mobile Vendors: The Village does not have a "dedicated" bylaw for Mobile Vendors, rather the requirements for a Mobile Vendor are outlined in the Village's Business Licence Bylaw and permit them to operate on privately owned property, similar to the "Trunk Sale" event that was held on May 11, 2024. More information can be obtained from the Village's website at www.mcbride.ca.
- Farmers Market: A Farmers Market is held in McBride at the Steve Kolida Park during the summer months and vendors operate under the auspices of the Farmers Market. More information can be obtained from the local Community Market Manager and Northern Health at www.northernhealth.ca.
