BC Summer Reading Club - A free literacy program designed to engage school-aged children, ages 5-14, with libraries and reading, throughout the summer. Each year has a different theme: this year's theme is World of Curiosities. Each participating child gets a logbook, to track their reading progress (with weekly stickers for completion!) and bookmarks. We will be running a series of weekly challenges for kids - and parents - to try. This year, to make it even more fun, we will be assigning everyone a House: the four houses are as follows: House of Unicorn, House of Mer, House of Dragon and House of Griffin. Reading logs are available at the library now; when you collect a reading log, you are assigned to a House! Children and parents will generate House points by completing weekly challenges, and their reading logs. The House with the most points at the end of summer will have the medal ceremony party decorated in their honour! We will have weekly prize draws too, and lots of prizes for kids of all ages.

Summer Book Bingo - Back this year, our reading program for adults. Pick up a "bingo card" and play along. There will be a prize winner at the end of the summer, and this is also a way to earn House points.

Wacky Wednesdays Summer Activities - starting 3rd July, our summer program for kids will be on Wednesday afternoons this year. Games, activities, learning, and lots of fun! 
