

## DEVELOPMENT BYLAWS & PROCEDURES REVIEW GRANT

- The Village was successful in obtaining a grant of \$92,029.20 to streamline and modernize its Development Bylaws and Procedures with the key goal of supporting development applications, for Re-zonings, Official Community Plan Amendments, Temporary Use Permits, Development Permits (including variances) and Subdivision applications.
- ❖ This Project will be underway in 2025 and will include a Community Open House - stay tuned for an announcement of the date!

# MCBRIDE AIRPORT CARDLOCK FUEL SYSTEM GRANT

The Village was successful in obtaining a BC Air Access grant for a Cardlock Fuel System at the McBride Airport for \$495,000, with Project completion expected early 2025. Both AV Gas and Jet Fuel will be available, which will support increased recreation and commercial activity, and help ensure fuel available during emergencies such as wildfires.

## 2025 BUSINESS FACADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
