

Test your smoke detectors once a month and occasionally practice your home fire escape plan so everyone knows what to do if an alarm goes off!

RECENTLY MOVED TO B.C.? SWITCH OVER YOUR ID!

If you have become a resident in British Columbia and need to change your driver's license, health card, or ID from a different province or country, it can be done at the Village Office!

- 2 valid pieces of ID are needed for all transactions
- A drivers abstract/history is needed for a driver's license switch
- To get a BC Services Card, you must first apply through Health Insurance BC (Medical Services Plan)
