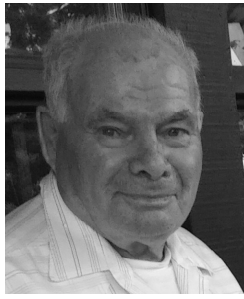

The first full week in April, coincides with the arrival of spring, when people naturally want to open the windows and let in fresh air.

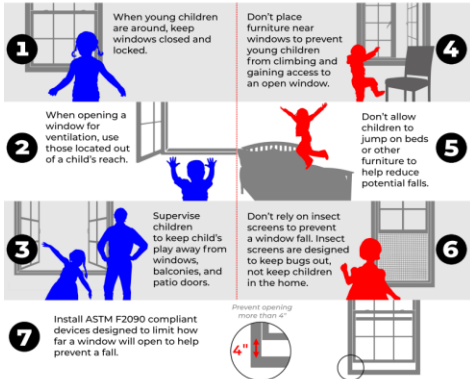
