**BOIL WATER NOTICE & WATER CONSERVATION NOTICE ISSUED**

June 9, 2025  
TO ALL VILLAGE OF MCBRIDE RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES  
In consultation with the Drinking Water Officer of the Northern Health Authority the Village of McBride is hereby issuing a "Boil Water Notice" pursuant to Section 14 of the Drinking Water Protection Act. In addition, the Village is also issuing a Water Conservation Notice to reduce water usage and help preserve the existing supply of water.

Warmer than seasonal temperatures have kicked off spring freshet conditions early and have resulted in rising turbidity in Dominion Creek, leading to the Notices.

This Boil Water Notice applies to all users of the Village of McBride water supply system (Operating Permit #2098) and must be followed by all persons using water from this system.
