The Village of McBride is pleased to report the WATER NOTICE and WATER CONSERVATION NOTICE issued June 9, 2025 for the Community Water System in response to elevated turbidity have both been rescinded, effective immediately

Water samples from the Community Water System confirm that turbidity levels in the water are within acceptable levels and the water is safe to drink. As such, Northern Health has lifted the Boil Water Notice. In addition, water levels are sufficient to remove the Water Conservation Notice.

The Village recommends that residents and business run their taps for 1-2 minutes prior to drinking.


