



- 1. Keep all solid waste securely stored until collection day.
- 2. Manage your fruit trees and berry bushes responsibly. Pick all your fruit as it ripens to ensure that windfalls do not accumulate
- Bird feeders often become bear feeders
- 4. Feed pet indoors
- 5. Keep your barbecue clean and free from odours.
- Manage your compost properly so it doesn't smell
- 7. If you keep chickens, bees, or small livestock, use a properly installed and maintained electric fence.



Back to School Tuesday September 2, 2025 ICBC shares safety tips for drivers



- Every school day, unless otherwise posted, a 30 km/h speed limit is in effect in school zones from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. In playground zones, a 30 km/h speed limit is in effect every day from dawn to dusk.
- Watch for school buses. When their lights are flashing, vehicles approaching from both directions must stop.
- Avoid distractions by leaving your phone alone while driving and watch for children walking, cycling or riding a scooter. Distracted and inattentive driving is a leading cause of crashes with pedestrians and cyclists.

2026 Permissive Tax Exemptions **Applications**

The Village of McBride is now accepting applications for 2026 Permissive Tax Exemptions. Section 224 of the Community Charter gives Council the authority to exempt certain land and /or improvements from municipal property taxes. Council considers Permissive Tax Exemptions for non-profit organizations that contribute to the wellbeing of Village residents and/or that make improvements to the quality of life for residents. To be eligible for a permissive tax exemption, an organization must comply with the guidelines as per Community Charter Section 224, Property Qualified for Permissive Tax Exemptions and be approved by Council.

The deadline for applications to be received by the Village Office is Thursday, September 18, 2025 at 12:00 noon.

Note: Organizations currently included in Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 831, 2024 will receive exemptions for a ten-year period, beginning in 2025 and ending in 2034.
