

BC DRAGIT CHALLENGE 2026

2nd ANNUAL SHOW & SHINE / FAMILY FUN DAY 2026 UPDATE

As the local contact / site organizer for the BC Dragit Challenge airport drags and the Annual Show and Shine / Family Fun Day, one of my goals is to try and promote our community as follows:

1. Attract out of town participants and visitors to fun filled entertaining events thus potentially generating much needed tourism revenue.
2. Attract possible new families who may contribute to our community and bring new ideas and possibly start businesses and get involved in local organizations and events.
3. Provide entertainment and put on events for the residents to participate in and breathe some new life into the community.
4. Promote our community and the non-profit and recreation groups and organizations we have within our area.

As part of promoting our recreational activities and organizations, Dannielle Alan of the McBride Visitor's Centre has offered to work with me in providing 100 handout packages for the racers and organizers to be passed out as they enter the facility. If this information can all be gathered well in advance of the event, I will mail it to the organizers to handout at the Tech Inspection at the start of the race series. Dannielle is arranging the brochures they have on hand and has offered to stuff the envelopes I am providing. These brochures apply to any **non-profit recreation group or organizations** within our area. This includes but is not limited to such groups as:

Car Clubs, Cross Country Ski Clubs, Curling Clubs, Downhill ski Clubs, Equestrian Clubs, Figure Skating clubs, Hiking Clubs, Hockey Clubs, Mountain Biking Clubs, Snowmobile Clubs and things of that nature. These organizations and clubs will have their brochures / pamphlets included in the package free of charge. The onus and responsibility of ensuring your information is included is up to you, as a non paid or compensated volunteer, I simply can not afford to go tracking groups and organizations down and contacting everyone personally. You can drop off your information pamphlets and brochures at the McBride Visitor's Centre during business hours at the Train Station at the South end of Main Street McBride. It is possible that they may already have your information on hand but it's up to you to confirm they have it.

In addition to this handout, we will set up a large poster at The McBride Visitor Centre for everyone to sign to be presented at the event, please be sure to add your name and show your support! Also included in the handout will be a list of the volunteers and contributors to this event so they receive the recognition and appreciation they deserve for making this awesome event such a huge success! On that note, we are still looking for donations or sponsors to cover the \$400.00 required for the public portable toilets, hopefully the businesses that gain financially from this event will step in and collectively cover that cost otherwise we will only have the use of the one outhouse located at the airport. One possible means of raising the required \$400.00 would be by offering **for-profit recreation businesses** such as Guided Dog Sled, Hiking, Rafting, Skiing, Camping tours, and things of that nature and **local businesses**, the opportunity to have their brochures or one page advertisements included in these handouts for the sum of \$50.00 with the funds going towards the Public Toilets.
