BCDragIT Challenge Update

It's been a while since I was able to update everyone on the progress and status due to a major computer issue but that's all taken care of now! We are less than two weeks away from once again having the privilege of hosting this awesome event! Things are in place as far as operations are concerned other than the actual set up of the venue. In an effort to streamline the process of volunteers signing on-line waivers for pit access, I will be holding a brief safety meeting / waiver signing session on Saturday June 13th. At The Raven's Nest Hotel between 3 p.m. and 5 p.m. I recommend all volunteers or groups that will be in the restricted area attend. There is limited cell service at the airport and no wifi available. If needed, a brief walk through of the grounds may be squeezed in for those that may need clarification on the layout of the venue etc. The airport is Village owned and Federally controlled so access at any time is limited and there are protocols in place for any activities or traffic in the restricted area.

The "Welcoming packages" are now here and the non-profit pamphlets are being stuffed as we speak, any of the groups or businesses that donated to the public washrooms that wish to have their pamphlets / advertisements included must be paid up to date and have their items returned to me before Saturday June 13th. By 6 p.m. I will be opening a bank account at Integris in McBride this coming Wednesday so I will be able to accept etransfers after that time. To any of the contributors to the public washrooms, if you would like a guided tour of the pits to meet the drivers, etc., please attend the safety training session at The Raven's Nest Hotel as listed above. This year I have purchased lanyards for all the volunteers, if you do not sign the waivers, have a lanyard or the proper designated wrist band, you will not be allowed access to the restricted areas. I will have spares on hand as sometimes things pop up such as media personnel etc. Emergency Service Personnel in uniform are exempt from these conditions but are either escorted or briefed on site as to the safety protocols in place.

On site final physical preparations will take place starting on Friday June 19th. at 9:00 a.m. As the NOTAM will be in place. The hardest job is installing the fencing and it would be great if some young bucks would like to come flex some muscles and pound the fence posts in, a great way to show off your strength and stamina :)! Unfortunately my Airport Road shuttle driver has an out of town medical appointment and will not be available so I am looking for a couple people to perform that task, if a couple people get on board they can alternate shifts and be able to catch some of the action of the racing as well. It involves making short trips making a loop along Airport and Shantz roads picking up people with lawn chairs etc. and dropping them off at the airport.

In order to avoid congestion upon completion of the event, parking will be on the right hand side of the road leaving the airport. People tend to stagger in at various times but leave around the same time, this created congestion at the airport end as people were trying to turn around as racers etc. were leaving. It will also ensure that you may not have to walk as far as there were spots available closer to the airport but people assumed parking spots were all taken up. There is limited handicap and senior parking so it is restricted to persons with Government issued handicap stickers (holder of permit must be in the vehicle) or those who receive a parking permit ahead of time.

Just a friendly reminder, no pets are allowed on the site, it is a Family Friendly Event and as such no alcohol or drugs allowed on site! Anyone under the influence or anyone causing a disturbance may be removed from site and possibly banned from future events. Bring lawn chairs and umbrellas and be prepared for some awesome fun filled racing action!
